\rightarrow What does this mean for me as a teacher to be a part of this course?

- If you agree to participate then you must complete the course. That means that you will need to spend ± 5 hours per week for 20 weeks participating in the course.
- \square The course material will be given to you in a book and on a mobile tablet.
- What is the tablet for? You will register, take a sample unit test, take a pre and post self-assessment test, take weekly tests and watch and take videos on the tablet.
